The class is facilitated by Regional Health Systems' professionals experienced with transitioning families. Participants receive a handbook to reference material learned.

- Arrive at least 15 minutes before it starts to check-in.
- Attend the class you chose as your first choice. No confirmation will be sent unless there's a change.
- After attending the entire class, you will receive a certificate and the court will be informed of your attendance.
- Child care is not provided. Do not bring children to class.

Cancellations

- No refunds for cancellation notices received 30 days after the registered class meets.
- Listen to WJOB (1230 AM) or WZVN (107.1 FM) for cancellations due to weather.
